**For our prayers during the coming week**

<b>Sunday</b>	Please pray for the work of the Gideons. Their primary aim is to distribute bibles into Hotels, Hospitals, Doctors' and Dentists', Schools, Colleges, Prisons and Homes for the elderly. Pray that the doors will remain open, new opportunities will arise and that people will be open.
<b>Monday</b>	We pray for the Joint Services that WCCYM helps to organise. Pray for the organisation of the next one, for the people leading and the people attending. Pray that these services continue to be a good opportunity for Christians from all over South Cambridgeshire to get together to worship, pray and learn together.

Also for the neighbouring ecumenical parish of <i>Cambourne</i> , and for the ministries there of Peter Wood and Pauline Scott.
<b>Friday</b>	We give thanks for the doctors, nurses, pharmacists and other staff in the surgeries in Bourn and Papworth. Pray for them with the pressures and the responsibilities they bear.
<b>Saturday</b>	'Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God' (Matthew 5:8). Pray that we will be pure in heart.
<b>Every day</b>	Please pray for Israel and Palestine, particularly for the Palestinians, Christians and Muslims, who have suffered so much there, and for the hope of a peaceful resolution to the problems. Please pray for David Kitching and for his part in seeking to bring peace to Jerusalem.
