Collect

For our prayers during the coming week

Sunday	The fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self control. Pray that these will grow in our own hearts and be visible to the world around us.
Monday	We pray for our District and County councillors. We thank God for their service freely given and pray for wisdom for them all.
Tuesday	We think today of all those involved in local communication. Pray for those who produce parish magazines and newsletters, and thank God for those who distribute them. Ask God to use these to encourage people and build up our communities. Pray for posters and pew sheets to be used.
Wednesday	Pray for God's love to comfort the bereaved, and pray for those supporting them. Remember those working with CRUSE Bereavement Care. Pray especially for those whose grief is deeply troubling.
Thursday	'Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, Lord, my strength and my redeemer.' (Psalm 19:14). Pray that we may be good witnesses for God by what we do and say.

Friday	Papworth Hospital. All staff in the hospital, for patients and relatives. For John Coombs in his work as Chaplain. For chaplaincy volunteers. For the work of the Papworth Trust.
Saturday	We remember the elderly and the housebound. Pray for them and for those who care for them and visit them. Remember home helps and carers. Give thanks for the informal as well as the formal networks of social care.
Everyday	Pray for the General Election taking place this week.
International Prayer Focus	Pray for Angola fighting an outbreak of Marburg Virus in the north. At least 244 people have died since October 2004. Pray that the outbreak may be contained and not spread to the cities; pray for medical staff who are at high risk (many have already died), as this is very contagious, has no cure or vaccine and is rapidly fatal.
