Saturday	Pray for our Parochial Church Council members. They have many responsibilities, for the life and worship of their parishes, but also for the fabric of their church, many of which are an ancient part of our national heritage.
Every day	Please continue to pray for those affected by last week's bombings.
International Prayer Focus	Hurricane Emily is in the Caribbean and threatening areas hit by Hurricane Dennis last week. Pray for all those countries in its path including Grenada still recovering from Ivan last September and Haiti hit last week which is one of the poorest countries in the world. Please also pray for the situation in Kenya where there is the worst tribal tension since independence. Several people have been killed and others have lost their livelihoods.
